Count birds seen and heard at your feeders, in your yard, or on your farm, from midnight to midnight: Monday, December 26, 2022.

Use the highest number of a species seen at one time. *Ex: If you see 10 cardinals at once in the morning, and later in the day you only see only 5 cardinals, your total number of cardinals is 10.*

Round Feeder observation hours to the nearest quarter-hour for the time a feeder was observed, not a sum of time for all individuals watching a feeder at the same time. *Ex: 2 people watching one feeder, 1 person watches from 8:00 - 9:00 and the other watches from 8:30 - 10:00, the total observation time for that feeder is two hours. If those 2 people watch two separate feeders, the time is added together for a total of two and a half hours.*

Fly-overs (hawks, crows, etc) and birds that are heard (like owls) also count.
